The 2021 CRU Sierra Madre Pinot Noir is sourced solely from the Sierra Madre Vineyard. First planted in 1971, the vineyard is located in Northern Santa Barbara County, near the western edge of the Santa Maria Valley. The Sierra Madre Vineyard is recognized as one of California’s finest cool-climate vineyards and the coldest vineyard in the state leading to a long, drawn-out growing season.

TASTING NOTES

This elegant wine bursts with aromas of strawberry, raspberry and cherry with a slight hint of earth. The palate is beautifully balanced with red fruit notes of strawberry and black cherry accented by mushroom and nutmeg. The finish is long and velvety, leaving you wanting another sip.

This complex and fruit forward wine is a beautiful accompaniment to big flavors. We recommend pairing it with pork tacos topped with chipotle and cherry salsa.
